


It is a disease caused by the consumption of contaminated food, contaminated water or drink, not washing hands properly, and swimming in dirty water.





Lead Poisoning

Lead contaminated water from old pipe can cause lead poisoning, one of the serious diseases caused by water pollution.



Dysentery

It is the name given to diseases that show symptoms such as frequent and bloody diarrhea in humans, usually severe abdominal pain, desire to defecate unnecessarily, and intestinal wounds.

Typhoid

Typhoid is a bacterial infection that causes high fever, diarrhea and vomiting and can be fatal.



HEPATITIS A

It is an infectious disease caused by the hepatitis A virus, involving the liver and characterized by jaundice. Since it is spread with feces, unclean water sources and foods washed with these waters pose a great risk for the spread of the virus.

Guinea Wolf Disease (Dracunculiasis)

The most common disease caused by water pollution is excessive and more frequent than normal, watery and loose stools.

It is one of the diseases caused by water pollution in Africa. People become infected with worms when they drink water contaminated with the larvae.



Malaria

It is a febrile illness caused by a mosquito carrying a parasite called Plasmodium that breeds in polluted water.



Trahom

Trachoma occurs in crowded settlements where water resources are limited and health service are inadequate. Transmission occurs through direct contact of patients with contaminated water, flies or the use of items such as towels and handkerchiefs.



Fluorosis

This disease, which causes severe bone disease, is due to high levels of fluoride naturally found in groundwater.
